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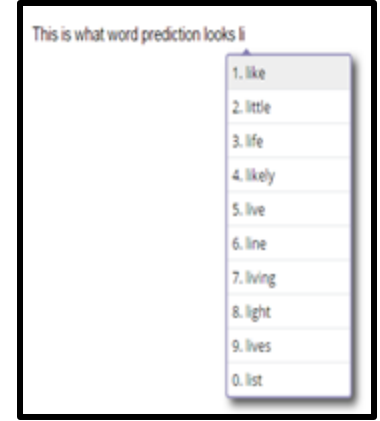

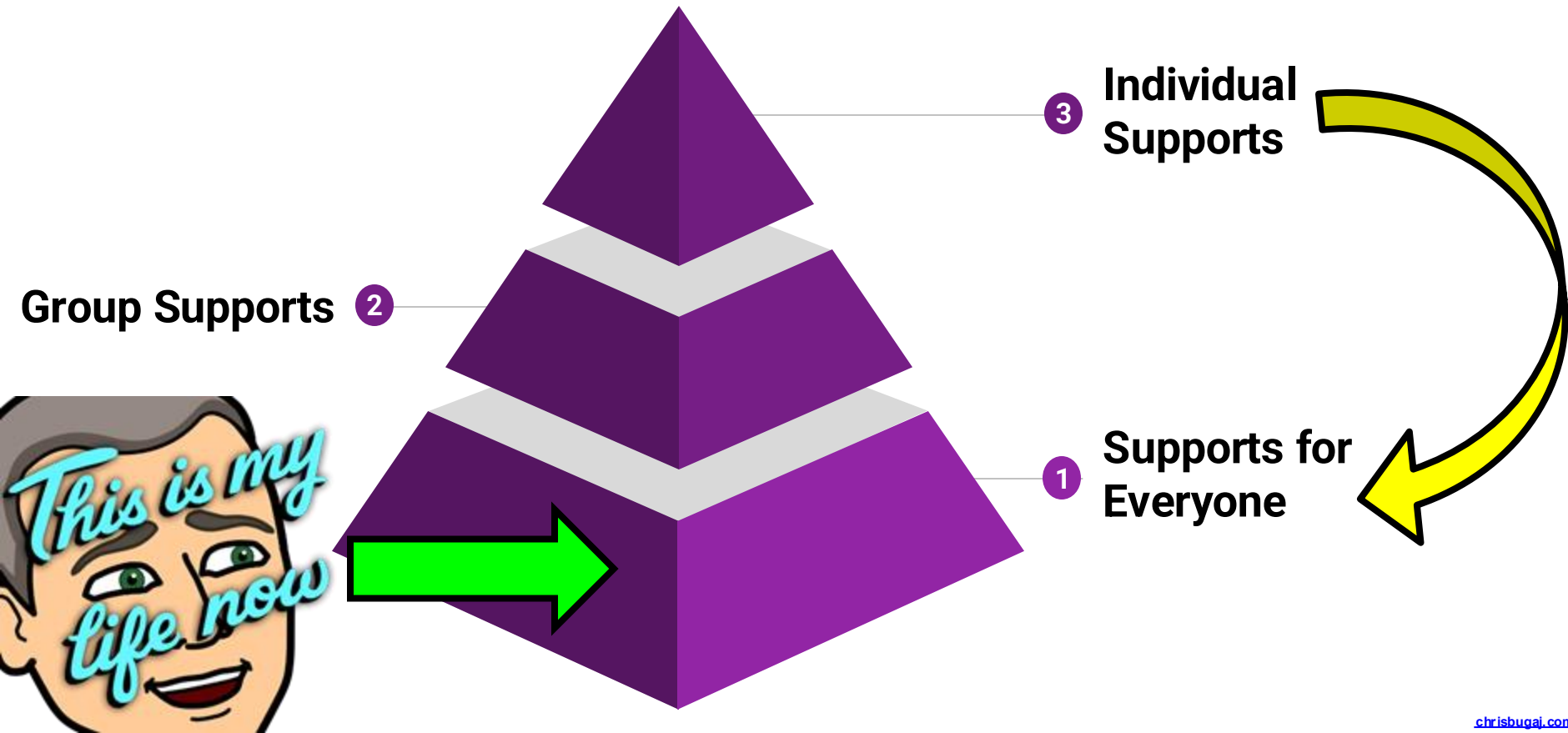

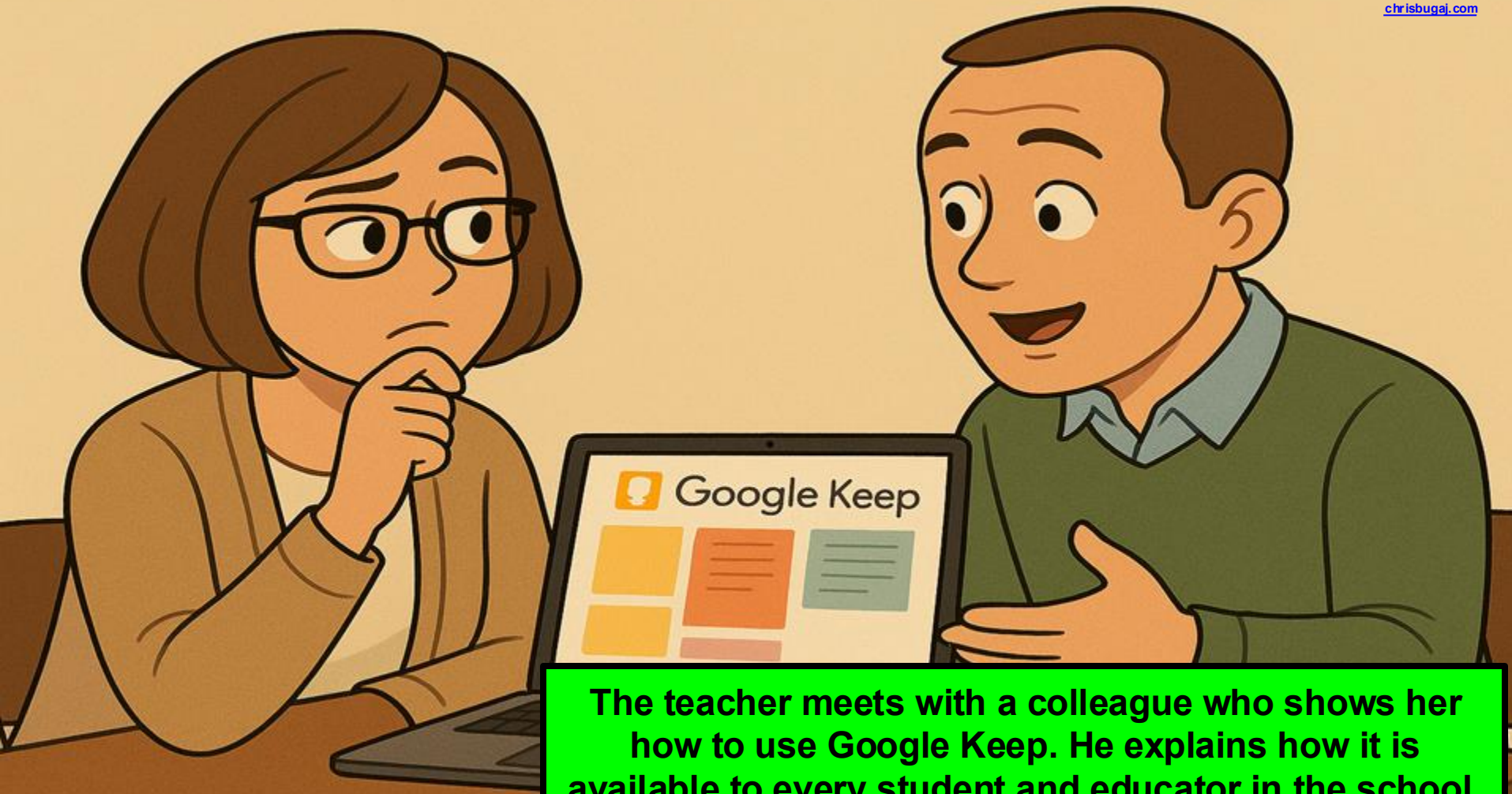

SCIENCE



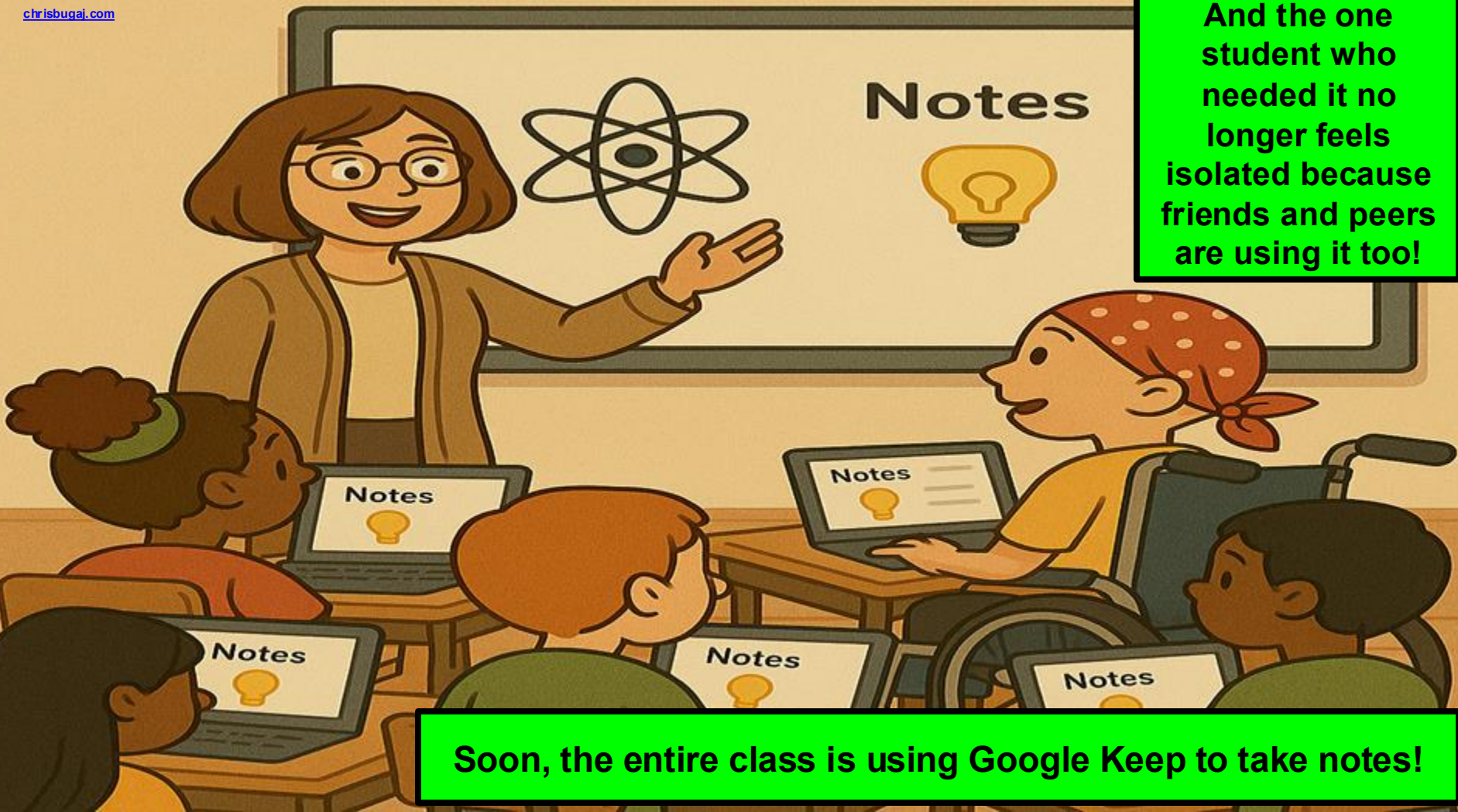
A girl in high school tells her teacher she remembers more if she can take notes digitally.



The teacher meets with a colleague who shows her how to use Google Keep. He explains how it is available to every student and educator in the school.



The teacher has an idea. She'll introduce this tool to every student!



And the one student who needed it no longer feels isolated because friends and peers are using it too!

Soon, the entire class is using Google Keep to take notes!
